BENEFICIARIES

540 pediatric patients and 270 family members of pediatric patients in the cardiovascular, burn and physical therapy wards. In addition, the project will benefit volunteers of Happier and the staff of hospitals where they work.

MAIN ACTIVITIES

Supporting pediatric patients through advisory services, encouragement, spiritual care, and life skills.

Providing additional knowledge and skills for the parents of child patients to help them deal with their pain and cooperate with necessary treatments, for a more speedy recovery.

Training to improve the capacity of Happier volunteers.

250,316,400 VND/year
