ORGANIZATION MISSION

- Support children with special needs with regard to their physical, mental and social health.
- Help children with special needs and their families to access educational, psychological and social services at hospitals and local communities

PROJECT'S PROBLEM ANALYSIS

Parents have difficulties in implementing interventions for children with autism at home because of these factors:

- Psychology: sad, denying, giving up, physically and mentally exhausted. They usually forget the guide of educators.
- Lack of resources: They have no time to teach children at home due to works. They do not understand that teaching and playing with their children are important for their development to social inclusion.
- There is no companion to support them, to guide them how to teach and play with their children.
- Parents also do not adhere to the treatment plan of the doctor.

PROJECT'S BENEFICIARIES

Direct beneficiaries: children with autism and their parents who will receive training and support.

Indirect beneficiaries: social work volunteers who will receive training, doctors and professionals working in Pediatrics Hospital 1.

PROJECT'S OBJECTIVES

- Building capacity for volunteers to support parents of children with autism with the interventions at home and make sure they adhere to the treatment plan.
- Building capacity for parents of children with autism on children development and social inclusion.
- Accompanying the parents so that they adhere to treatment plans and doctor's appointments.

PROJECT'S DESIRED OUTCOMES

- 80% of pediatric patients in the program will improve their skills, which will be evaluated through examination by doctors and special educators.
- 80% of parents in the program will improve their awareness through adherence to treatment plans and their skills of teaching and playing with children, which will be evaluated through examination by doctors and special educators.
- 100% of volunteers in the program will be equipped with skills to work with children with autism and their parents, to be active in supporting and helping parent at home, which will be supervised by educators and social specialists.

PROJECT'S ACTIVITIES

Train volunteers to accompany parents with the following activities:

Timing	Activities
Week 1 of first month	Training of teamwork skill for the volunteer group Training of intervention theory for parents of children with autism
Once a week in 10 months	Organize the meetings for the parents groups
Once a week in 10 months	Support parents in intervention for children with autism at home
Once per 3 months	Examination and treatment orientation for child patients
Once per 3 months	Evaluation Test (input and output) to develop teaching programs for children at home

Once per month	Evaluation Test on the home support plan of volunteers (house visit)

Parents	Participate in surveys Commit to participate in all training sessions and support volunteers
Volunteers	Participate in group intervention, commit to accompany parents and report to supervisors.

PROJECT'S SUSTAINABILITY

- "Parents of Children with autism" club will be established and run by parents with the help of experts to share information, knowledge, skills as well as connect resources.
- Parents who are trained will become volunteers supporting new parents, expanding the model with help from experts.
- Organize meetings for parents in other areas to exchange experience, implement and replicate the model.
